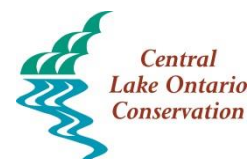


Teacher Action	Deadline Date	Details

<input type="checkbox"/> <i>Contact Teacher: fill out Invoice and submit to school office and Festival Coordinator as Confirmation</i>	Friday Sept. 14, 2018	Once final numbers have been received, CLOCA will organize and confirm bussing and add you to Aboriginal Voices schedule. You may confirm online (link provided on invoice) or fax invoice or email invoice.
